Here are ten (10) word references to dance in the bible, Greek and Hebrew.

Greek descriptions for dance/movement:

1. Agalliao – jump for joy (rejoice greatly)
2. Choros – a round dance
3. Exallomai – to jump (to leap, to spring up, to gush)
4. Orchos – circular dance (a row or ring, dance, dancing, a band of dancers and singers, a dance)

Hebrew descriptions for dance/movement:

5. Chagag – to move in a circle (to march in a sacred procession)
6. Kara – to bend the knee (to sink, to prostrate, bow down self, bring down low)
7. Ragad – to stamp (to spring about, aloud, noise, shouted)
8. Alats or Alaz – to jump for joy (exult, be joyful, rejoice, triumph)
9. Chuwl – to twist (whirl in a spiral manner, to dance, writhe, fear, tremble, travail, be in anguish, to be pained.
10. Giyl – rejoice (a revolution, exceeding joy, gladness, greatly)
